

The Five Themes of Geography

Location:

-Absolute: The exact location of a place. Geographers use latitude and longitude lines to pinpoint absolute location.

-Relative: Where a location is in relation to places or things near it.

Place: The physical and human characteristics of a location. Physical characteristics include things such as mountains, rivers, and beaches. Human characteristics include things such as political institutions, culture, housing.

Human-Environment Interaction:

How humans and the environment affect one another.

Movement: The study of the movement of people, goods, and ideas from one place to another.

Regions: The basic unit of study in geography. A region is an area that has certain unifying characteristics such as climate, language, or history.



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
